Simplifying words

Hot and Hazardous Atmosphere permit

TYPE
For hot or cold work on burner equipment use the Burner Work Permit

Do I need this permit?
Yes, if:

- You are doing work that creates a risk of ignition from sparks or heat (eg grinding, welding, flame cutting, reduction of size or live electrical work)
- The first stage is required when there is a hot item in a hazardous atmosphere (eg flammable gases or fumes, the second stage of the permit is for general hot work)

Yes, also:

- Use of oil
- Risk of marking paint
- Dense fuel tanks or boilers (boilers and burners)
- Resonance tanks

No, if:

- You're in an approved hot work area and have completed a Hot Work Designate of Area (HotWork DoA)
- You are certain there is nothing within your work area that could catch fire or explode (eg)
- It is part of the normal operation (eg burner on a burner sprayer or BSO lot)
- You are simply starting a vehicle using appropriate tools and techniques

Is WorkSafe notification required?
No

What else do I need?
You may need a Hot Working Permit appropriate to the work being done. Services due annually, pressure checks & vents.

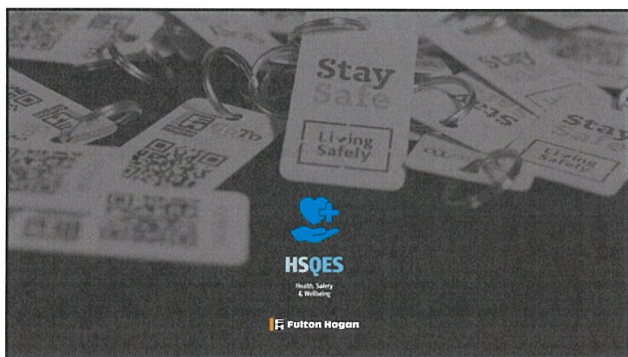
